A NATION CHANGED THROUGH THE MIRACULOUS

Liberia, West Africa was torn by the ravages of war, but God's healing love has forever changed this nation.

KLM International's crusade in the capitol city of Liberia was a tremendous success. After nearly two years of labor and planning, everything came together and greatly impacted the city and the nation. Liberia has suffered years of civil war and unrest. Inflation has caused prices of everyday commodities to skyrocket and there have been severe shortages of food. The people were hungry spiritually and physically. I don't think I've ever been to a nation so ready for change.

Our crusade team based out of Ghana, West Africa, had been working in the city for several months before my arrival. Our directors faced many trials and struggles in planning this event. There were several times it took everything within them to press forward to facilitate what God had planned for this country. After years of war, corruption had infiltrated every level of society. Nothing was exempt. Government, police, judges, churches, pastors, and even families had been infected. However, our staff stayed sharp and kept on. The results of their determination were phenomenal.

Despite the opposition and the many struggles, we continued to plan, schedule and promote the event. Having encountered many delays, we found ourselves right in the middle of the rainy season. The local pastors and leaders e-mailed and called our office in the United States many times recommending that we postpone the crusade until after the first of the year. During the rainy season, the rains come strong several times a day, most usually in the morning and in the evening. According to the local pastors we would be lucky to have one night in

the whole week without rain. They went on to explain that most of the people walk and few would venture out, knowing they would be caught in the seasonal storms. The week before I left for Africa, reports were coming in daily of the torrential downpours occurring two to three times a day. With a faith in God and a bit of stubbornness we decided that nothing would postpone this event again.

As I left the Pastors Conference the second day, I looked into the sky from my car window. The clouds, black and heavy, were beginning to gather. As we passed the crusade grounds I whispered under my breath, "Clear skies in the Name of Jesus." Our first night crusade was scheduled to begin at 4:00 PM. When I reached my hotel to prepare, I looked out my window. About that time the sky was dark and ominous looking. Instead of worrying, I sat back down on my bed and continued my preparation for the meeting. At



7:00 PM the call came from the lobby to let us know our ride to the grounds had arrived. The pastor and the driver excitedly told us how the storm clouds had broken out in rain on every side of town except where the crusade field was. They further explained that a wind came across the capitol city and blew the rain bearing clouds out to the ocean. Night after night this happened. Our crusade went an entire week without one drop of rain on the crusade field!

On the last night of the crusade there were over 50,000 in attendance, many of which traveled by foot. We had a powerful night of miracles and salvations. Thousands gave their hearts and lives to Jesus! What a glorious night we had in the presence of God. There was dancing and praising as waves of God's refreshing presence came down from heaven. At the close of the night we publicly thanked the Lord for the miracle of keeping the rain at bay.

Nearly one hour after I dismissed the crowd, ample time for those who attended the crusade to reach their homes, our team was enjoying a meal and soft drinks. We were discussing all of the wonderful things God had done. Suddenly there was a mighty clap of thunder that shook the building. Rain began to pour from the sky. This was not just a shower but a seasonal downpour, the kind the pastors had warned us about. (By the way, it rained all night.) We all just looked at each other in amazement. Soon smiles and laughter replaced the wonder. God had held the rain for an entire week. It stopped the day we arrived and began again one hour after our crusade had finished. With over 100,000 decisions reported during this event, it's evident that this sign and wonder along with the reported miracles has changed this nation forever!

Miracle Reports



During the crusade Christ showed Himself alive and powerful through the many notable miracles that He did among the people. So many miracles took place that we don't have enough room in this publication to print the pictures and describe all of them. We did select several outstanding undeniable miracles that shook the city of

Monrovia and caused an awe of God and His Greatness. Each night our ushers were instructed by our staff to seat all the crippled, lame, blind and deaf in the front of the crowd, directly in front of the platform. During this particular crusade people began to bring the bedridden and paralyzed as early as midday for the evening service.

The gentleman seen in the photos above and to the right, received two powerful miracles at the crusade. He had been paralyzed for several years and was carried to the crusade. As I preached the message I was drawn to this man. He sat in the front, his legs were sticking straight out in front of him. During most of the message he sat with his head hung low and rarely looked to the platform, but when we began to pray I noticed him try to straighten himself up a little. I motioned to him and asked if he wanted to be healed. He shook his head yes and pointed to his legs. I asked him if he could move them, and he shook his head no. I said, "In the Name of Jesus begin to move your legs!" He looked back at me like I was crazy. By now many people were straining to get to the front to see what was happening. A situation like this can get dangerous with a crowd of 40,000 to 50,000 so I had to do something quick. I told the man, "Grab your pant legs and begin to move your legs." He

did, and a smile went across his face as he had sensed a change. I told him, "Now, rise and walk!" Again he looked at me like I was crazy. With the crowd pressing to see the miracle in progress I told the ushers to help the man to his feet. They did and much to the man's surprise he didn't immediately crumble to the ground. No, he stood! He walked! With ushers standing on each side of him he began by taking baby steps and the crowd went wild! After just a few moments he was walking without any assistance and was getting stronger with each step. Knowing that most of the crowd couldn't see this miracle in progress I asked the ushers to bring him to the platform for everybody to witness what God was doing.

As the man got to the top of the stairs I took his hand and we began to walk back and forth across the stage. With each pass he got stronger and more confident with his newfound legs. After the fourth or fifth lap he was out walking me! It was then that he fully grasped what God had done. He lifted both his hands in thanksgiving to God and the crowd began to praise God for the mighty deed they witnessed. After several minutes I brought this man, brimming with joy, to the center of the stage and asked him to tell us about the miracle. I placed the microphone toward his mouth. He was only able to gurgle and mumble. He put his hand to his throat and shook his head no. He was mute! Not shaken, I said to the crowd, "Look at this beautiful man. Look at the miracle God has done for him. God isn't finished with him yet. He doesn't want him mute. How can he tell people about his miracle being mute?" I asked, then laid my hands on him and commanded the mute spirit to leave him. I leaned over and whispered in his ear, "Jesus." He





spoke back, "Jesus." I said, "Hallelujah." He said, "Hallelujah." I said, "Father." He said, "Father." The crowd once again erupted with joy. God did two wonderful miracles for this man. He caused his paralyzed legs to be made whole and restored his speech!

What notable miracles and a powerful testimony to Jesus' resurrection!

After witnessing this miracle, the faith of those who watched was inspired. Many of the lame and crippled rose and began to shed their crutches and canes. Many of them were healed in a matter of minutes. This mighty move of God astounded me. These acts inspired many others to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.



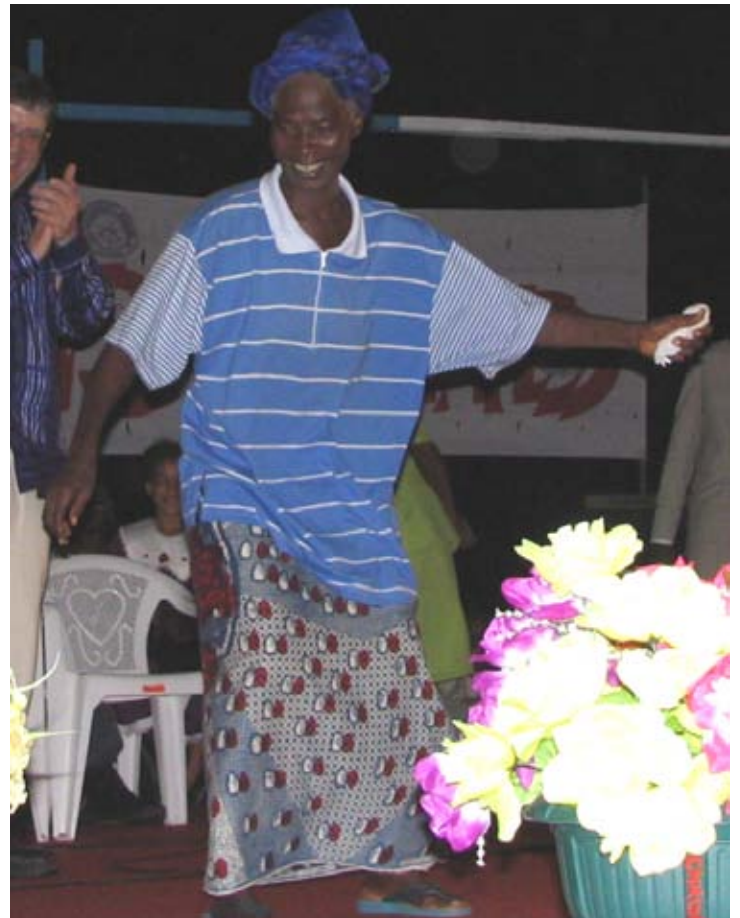
In the picture below, this young 23-year-old woman sighs with relief. She had been bedridden for months and was being supported by her eldest brother. Doctors had come and had given up hope on her. Her entire family knew she was going to die. Days before the crusade she had been taken to the street by her oldest brother. He knew he couldn't afford her funeral, so he decided she should die on the streets where at least the government would find her body and bury it. Her younger brother found out about the crusade by reading a poster and decided



he would find his sister, clean her up and carry her to the grounds. She was miraculously healed by God's touch. She joyously

expressed her thanksgiving and relief over and over again. Her testimony touched the hearts of all that listened.

This precious grandmother was born with a deformed hip. She learned to walk at the age of two by using a crutch. For 63 years she walked by placing all of her weight on the crutch. During the prayer she felt her petition was granted. She took her first step ever without her crutch. In this picture she is nearly running across the platform with me. What a glorious night for her and her family.



Having been blind for nearly six years and after many failed surgeries this Liberian woman dances with joy as the hand of the Lord has opened her eyes!

This man's hip was so far gone he could barely walk. He tried to hide the pain from his wife, but she said his condition was obvious. He came to hear the message and to be healed. Several years ago this woman suffered a stroke. The stroke left the right side of her body paralyzed and her right eye blind. She bounded up the stairs waving her arms in the air. She not only had complete mobility and strength restored, but she also testified she could now see out of her blinded eye. In the photo above we are verifying her miracle by having her count the fingers on my hand! She and her family were elated at what God had done for them.

For years this young man was unable to work due to a severe rupture in his stomach. He told us he had always been strong but for several years his intestines would bulge through his muscles causing excruciating pain. He explained the



pressure was so great, when lifting items, he feared his skin might burst. When we began to pray he said he sensed the healing power of God all over his body. When he reached down and touched his stomach he found the rupture was completely gone!



This woman was blind for nearly seven years. Her powerful testimony lifted the people's faith. Here she proves her miracle by describing the crowd that she now sees. To the people's delight she kept pointing out certain colors and patterns in the clothes they were wearing.



The young man pictured below had an amazing story. His right shoulder was severely deformed and his arm had hung lifeless at his side for over five years. The doctors had told him that he had to have his arm amputated. His friends laughed at him when he read one of the posters and said he wanted to go to the crusade. Despite their poking fun they came along with him, eight in all. They all reverently bowed their heads and closed their eyes as we prayed. When they closed their eyes their friend had his left arm stretched to heaven and his right arm hung dead at his side. When we finished praying they opened their eyes and witnessed their friend twirling his right arm wildly in the air. Screaming and yelling in astonishment at their friend's miracle, they made such a commotion that all attention was drawn toward them. When I spoke to them from the platform they rushed their friend to the stage. With tears in his eyes he told us his story and demonstrated his restored arm. God had given him a great gift! Needless

to say those eight friends weren't joking around anymore. Through this healing and hundreds of others just like it, Jesus' resurrection became an undeniable reality. The people of Liberia no longer believe just because of what they have heard. Now, they believe because of the evidence of the miracles. Their faith doesn't rest in the wisdom of men, but in the Power of God!

Leadership Conference

In the Great Commission, Jesus instructed us to do two things. First, He commanded us to go (into all the world) and proclaim the Good News. Secondly,



He commanded us to make disciples, teaching them to obey Jesus and His ways. I realize that I am an Evangelist, that's not just my calling but that is what I do. An evangelist

proclaims the Gospel. We declare the Good News. We preach His substitution for us: Jesus' death, His burial and His resurrection! Now that's our focus, but for me to deny my commanded responsibility to teach and to make disciples would be ludicrous. That's why KLM International spends so much time and money to train the local leaders and pastors.

As a part of each major event, we endeavor to lift and inspire the leaders and pastors of each country we are



called to. Many pastors come from the interior of the countries and some even from neighboring nations. The pastors come by faith and most come with no money for food or lodging. We arrange lodging with the local churches in the city and feed the pastors during the day. If the pastors come from out of the city we endeavor to give them travel fare for their way home. We do this because we believe in these pastors. Few have had the privilege of Bible College or Seminary and many of these pastors have never had any formal training. I have met several pastors who

have taken on their responsibilities because they were the first one saved in their village or they were the only one who could read. The time that we spend sowing into their lives is vital to the future of the church and to the new believers that come to them as a result of the crusade.

We may not be able to stay months and years after each crusade to train the new believers, but these pastors will be there. Through these intense sessions we equip the pastors who live in the country to disciple the new converts from the soul winning event. I believe God's heart and desire is for the indigenous gospel worker to link arms with the new convert. To come along side them and help them find out how to live their new life in Jesus Christ. One of our keys to winning the nations to Jesus is by holding leadership conferences. As the pastors and leaders are enlightened and inspired, they in turn enlighten and inspire the people. When the people are enlightened and inspired they will carry the Gospel to the rest of their nation. Some will go farther and take the Gospel to the neighboring nations.

We not only spend time ministering the Word, but we also spend time praying over these precious laborers. Many of these men and women will never again have the opportunity to sit under somebody else's teaching.



This time of training is special to them. During our prayers, gifts are activated and imparted. For some it is a time of sanctification. For others it is a time of rededication and infilling. During this particular leadership conference we had 1,342 pastors registered and over 8,000 in attendance. We were also honored that three of Liberia's top Presidential candidates came to be taught. These pastors and leaders represent the Body of Christ in Liberia.

Thank you for sending us! Because of your prayers and financial gifts we were able to reach a nation and it's leaders. As you look at the faces in the picture below, I want you to hear these pastors say these words: "Thank you for coming to our nation!" "Thank you for ministering to us!" "Thank you for doing more than just preaching at the crusade!" "I'll never be the same!"

These are the words I have heard countless times. They are words spoken not just to me, not just to my family and staff; they are spoken to you as well.

Liberia, West Africa Relief

Preaching the gospel is one thing. Getting the converts into the local church is quite another. Relief programs like this, bridge the gap between the prayer of salvation and discipleship. These programs are vital to the local church.



Life in Liberia has been more than difficult. After nearly two decades of war and corruption the nation needs help. The people of Liberia are not only hungry for God, but many of them are hungry from a lack of food. Their markets and vendors are poorly stocked. It is not uncommon to see many vendors with only one or two cans of food for their entire inventory. As the food is scarce the prices are high. Demand and inflation are exceeding the people and their needs. The average Liberian family brings in only \$11.00 per month. That puts 80% of the population below the poverty line of Africa. This level of income is shocking considering rice now sells for over \$50.00 a bag.

The situation in the nation grew so bad that reports of cannibalism were coming from within the capitol city. The United Nations (UN) has come and given much aid to the nation, but most of the impact of these contributions are never felt at the level of the common man. In all reality, the presence of the UN has caused inflation to increase at unprecedented levels. That's one of the reasons we began working with Feed The Hungry (FTH) on this project over a year ago.



Because of the generosity of FTH and many of their supporters, we were able to ship eight full sized containers jammed with much needed food.



Thousands of pounds of rice, dried fruits, concentrated soup mix and flour arrived nearly a month before our crusade. With the help of some very dedicated and honest pastors we were able to gather over 200 churches in the city to act as distribution sites. This method assured us that the food would reach the people and empower the pastors.



Our job as international evangelists is not only preaching the gospel. We also have a deep desire to see the thousands of souls that come to Christ, as a result of our crusades, to become part of a local church. It's under the leadership of a good pastor that these precious people will be disciplined. It's in the local church where they will find their destiny and learn to walk out the plan God has for their lives. That's why this type of outreach following a crusade is so vital.



On the last night of the crusade the people received information about the distribution centers, which were located at the churches. This allowed them to find the center (church) closest to them. The week following the crusade the cooperating churches were converted into distribution centers. Each person received a wonderful food package and they also received one-on-one personal

ministry from the pastor or leaders. This program creates a bridge from the conversion experience to the local church for discipleship. It is one of the most effective tools we've ever used to bring the masses from the crusades into the local church. By the time I left Liberia over 45,000 had already registered to come to the churches. That's apostolic, that's powerful! Thank you Feed the Hungry! Thank you friends and partners! Together we are making a difference!

Ministerial Testimony:

Rev. John MacMarley & Evelyn Manlay; Monrovia, Liberia

With the terrible suffering and daily increased rate of starvation that Liberian's experienced in and around Monrovia in recent times, the life-saving and soul winning initiatives by KLM International and Feed The Hungry, were a tremendous relief to the war-affected, improvised and starving population of Monrovia and its environs.

By December 2004, rice, which is the staple food of Liberia, could hardly be found on the local market. As a result, the price of rice has skyrocketed. February 15 this year, one could hardly find good rice in the local market. For the interiors and areas outside of Monrovia, most families were now returning to eating wild roots. Malnutrition and starvation have become very evident in the country.

When people heard about the crusade and relief effort in Monrovia, pastors and church leaders from every part of Liberia came to Monrovia to participate in the crusade and leadership seminar. The pastors and leadership conference had an average attendance of 1,576 pastors, ministers and church workers. During the crusade, there were 59,977 recorded salvations and 58,743 recorded rededication of lives to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The follow-up process has been remarkably successful. Churches in and around Monrovia that participated in the crusade have been reporting tremendous increase in their discipleship and food distribution program. Up to present, churches have reported a turn out of over 135, 860 people at their churches participating in the discipleship and food ration distribution program.

There have been a lot of praise reports from churches about increases in church attendance. Pastors and church members are very happy and thankful that the brethren in the USA were generous in sending a consignment of relief items valued over \$95,000.00 and \$7,000.00 in cash to help in distributing the relief. To God be the glory! From the Pastors and churches of Liberia, Thank you!
